#### 1 Timothy 3:1-16

Introduction: Today we will look at what God's Word has to say regarding elders and deacons and how that Word applies to all of us.

#### Reading of the Word- 1 Timothy 3:1-16

### From Article X section 1 of the constitution under our bylaws

#### **B.** Qualifications for Elders:

Evidence of Christian maturity as described in 1 Timothy 3: 1-7 and Titus 1: 5-9 as follows: Above reproach, faithful to his wife, temperate, self-controlled, respectable, upright, holy and disciplined, hospitable, able to teach, not given to drunkenness, not violent but gentle, not quarrelsome, not a lover of money. He must manage his own family well and see that his children obey him, and he must do so in a manner worthy of full respect. He must not be a recent convert, or he may become conceited and fall under the same judgment as the devil. He must also have a good reputation with outsiders, so that he will not fall into disgrace and into the devil's trap. Since an overseer manages God's household, he must be blameless-not overbearing, not quick-tempered, pursuing dishonest gain, and one who loves what is good. He must hold firmly to the trustworthy message as it has been taught, so that he can encourage others by sound doctrine and refute those who oppose it.

Evidence of a dedicated, spirit-filled walk with the Lord. A member in good standing of the Church.

Agreement with the doctrinal beliefs and demonstration of loyalty to the policies and practices of The Christian and Missionary Alliance.

Willingness to be discipled.
