I. The Temptation. Gen 3

- A. Did God really say? V.1
 - 1. Satan will attempt to twist God's words.
- B. But God did say...V. 3 Eve changes God's words. (Gen 2:17)
- C. Another lie or two. You won't die. V.4. You will be like God. V. 5
- *When we start thinking we know what's best for ourselves it quickly leads to trouble.


II. The choice. Jer 2:8-13

- A. Exchanging God in all His glory for worthless idols. V.11 B. Two sins.
 - 1. They have forsaken God.
 - 2. Dug their own cisterns. V.13
- *They started thinking, I know a better way.

III. The Solution. John 4:4-14

- A. Living water. V. 10 (not dead, not stagnant, this is relationship vs. rules & religion)
- B. Spring of water welling up to eternal life. V. 14 (abundant life! John 10:10)
- *We have to make a decision to either rely on ourselves or rely on God.

Conclusion/application- Each day we get to choose. Will I drink from the Living Water? Will I walk in the Spirit and keep in step with the Spirit? Or will I choose to be comfortable? Complacent? Religious?
