#### Prayer as confession by Jorge Cuevas

"Forgive us our debts as we also have forgiven our debtors." – Matthew 6:12

Confession is a cry for relief from the weight of sin in our lives. Ps. 51:1–4, 2 Sam. 11&12. Ps 32:3–4

- A. Respond to the ministry of the Word of God.
- B. Acknowledge the debilitating effects of sin.
- C. Recognize that sin cannot be kept hidden for long.
