- **A.** Famine in the land. Ruth 1:1-2
- B. Death in the family. Ruth 1:3-5


II. A word of hope.

- A. God provides food for Bethlehem (house of food). Ruth 1:6
- B. Naomi heads home. Ruth 1:6-15

III. Ruth shows her quality

- A. Ruth commits herself to Naomi. Ruth 1:16-17
- B. Ruth commits herself to the God of Naomi (and Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob). Ruth 1:16-17
- C. Naomi reveals her brokenness. (Mara-because the Lord has made my life bitter. 1:20-21

Conclusion: In the book of Ruth, we see devotion and loyalty exemplified by Ruth in beautiful ways. Where in your life are you "empty" and in need of God's "fullness"? Who around you is struggling and in need of encouragement?
