Hebrews 10:32-39 (NIV) ³² Remember those earlier days after you had received the light, when you endured in a great conflict full of suffering. ³³ Sometimes you were publicly exposed to insult and persecution; at other times you stood side by side with those who were so treated. ³⁴ You suffered along with those in prison and joyfully accepted the confiscation of your property, because you knew that you yourselves had better and lasting possessions. ³⁵ So do not throw away your confidence; it will be richly rewarded. ³⁶ You need to persevere so that when you have done the will of God, you will receive what he has promised. ³⁷ For, "In just a little while, he who is coming will come and will not delay."³⁸ "But my righteous one will live by faith. And I take no pleasure in the one who shrinks back."³⁹ But we do not belong to those who shrink back and are destroyed, but to those who have faith and are saved.
