# Hope Awakened

## Ruth 2:14-23

Introduction: Boaz continues to watch out for Ruth and goes “above and beyond the law”. Naomi takes note and introduces Ruth to the idea of a “kinsman redeemer”.

- B. Good news. V. 19 & 21.

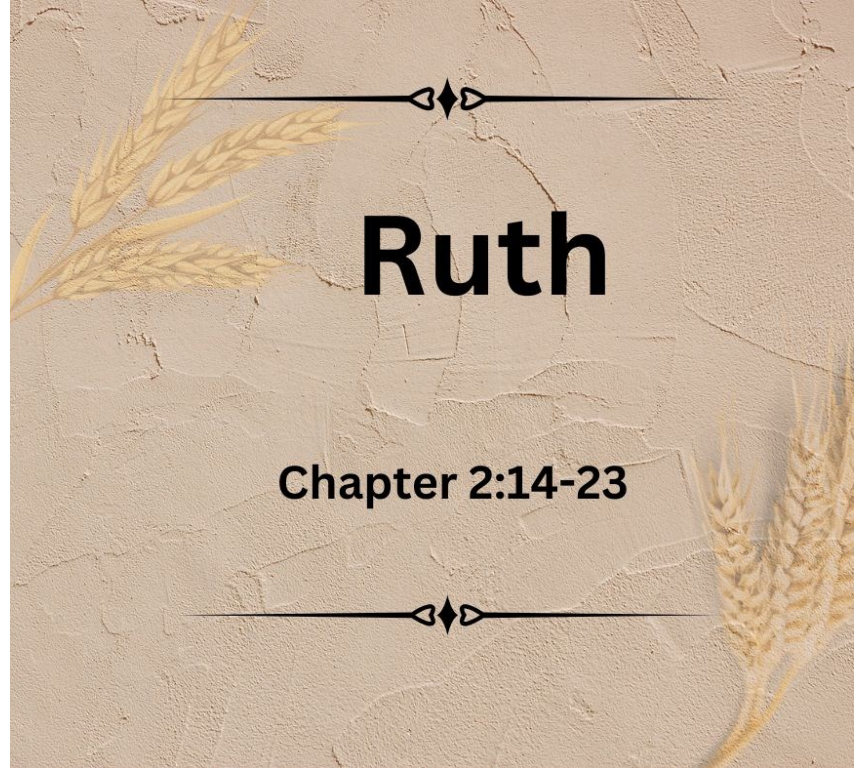
### III. Naomi gives her blessing.

**Conclusion:** *In the Pentateuch, a kinsman-redeemer has the responsibility to act on behalf of a relative who is in danger, trouble, or need. This includes:*

- *Caring for a deceased relative's possessions, such as land, livestock, houses, and even the widow*
- *Paying off debts at their own expense*
- *Taking the widow as wife*
- *Redeeming land*
- *Providing a son to continue the deceased father's name*

*We will continue to explore the idea of a redeemer as we draw closer to the celebration of our redemption on resurrection Sunday! “ I know my redeemer lives...”*
