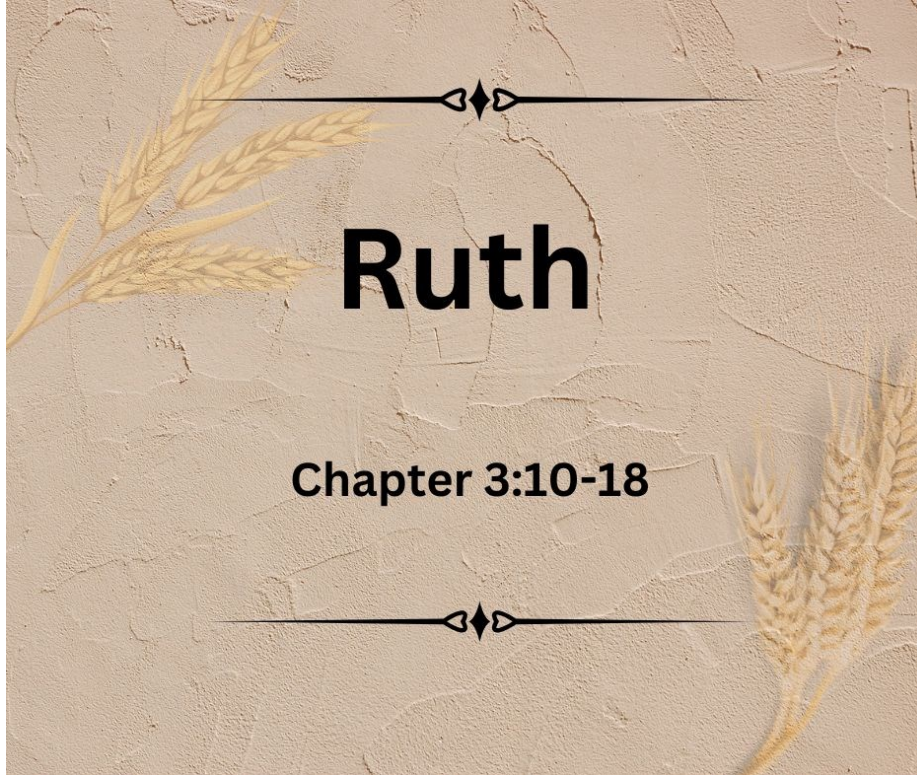
Hope that leads to a promise

Ruth 3:10-18

Introduction: Boaz responds to the situation with Ruth with integrity. He is willing to accept all the responsibilities that come with being a kinsman-redeemer.

- I. Boaz bestows his blessing.
A. He asks the Lord to bless Ruth and recognizes her kindness. V. 10 & 2:11-12
B. He extols her virtue. V. 10-11 ("Noble character"-same Hebrew word used to describe Boaz in 2:1)
C. He promises to take care of her. V. 11
II. Boaz makes a declaration.
A. There is another kinsman-redeemer. V.12
B. Boaz shows his integrity. V. 13-14
1. Towards Ruth (he tells her to stay the night with noble intentions)
2. Towards his relative.
3. Keeping her visit a secret.
III. Boaz & the barley.
A. He gives a gift of grain to Ruth and Naomi. V. 15-17
B. "Empty handed". (Again, we see the empty/full language). Chap 1:21
C. Final instructions. "Wait" v. 18

Conclusion: In the book of Ruth, we see God's plan unfold bringing together these two people of "noble character". Ruth chose to wait upon the Lord and do what she felt was right. Boaz treated her with dignity and respect. Are you willing to "wait" on the Lord? Do you believe that HIS blessings are the best thing you can ask/pray for?
