Ruth 4:1-12


Introduction: Boaz keeps his word and attends to the business of "redemption". He redeems the land, "acquires" Ruth, and receives a blessing from the elders.

- I. Boaz heads to the "town gate" (The normal place for business and legal transactions to take place).
 - A. He planned to talk to his relative. V. 1
 - B. He gathered ten of the elders of the town. V. 2
 - C. He presents the situation to the kinsman-redeemer. V. 3
 - D. The kinsman-redeemer declines the offer. V. 6-8

II. Boaz makes his announcement.

- A. He bought the property of Elimelech, Kilion, and Mahlon. V. 9
- B. He acquired Ruth the Moabitess. V. 10
- C. The elders gave their blessing. V. 11-12
 - 1. That Ruth would be like Rachel and Leah.
 - 2. That Boaz would have standing in Ephrathah and be famous in Bethlehem.
 - 3. That their family would be like that of Perez whom Tamar bore to Judah.

Conclusion: Boaz trusts the Lord and moves forward with integrity and honesty. The situation worked out the way that he hoped and God adds another interesting name to the family line of Jesus.
