The Triumphal Entry

Introduction: The Festival of Passover is the festival of redemption, the anniversary of the redemption from Egypt. Jewish tradition anticipates the arrival of Messiah-the second Moses and ultimate redeemer-at Passover time. Most of the people arriving in Jerusalem for the Passover that spring had not seen Yeshua for six months. Six months earlier, at the feast of Sukkot, they had heard him speak in the Temple, and many believed in Him. They hoped to see him again at Passover. They said to one another, "what do you think? Is He coming to the festival?" -Chronicles of the Messiah FFOZ

Scripture reading: Luke 19:28-42, Zechariah 9:9, Psalm 118 The acclamations fall into two categories

I. O LORD do save, (Hosanna)-Psalm 118:25

- * Mt 21:9-Hosanna to the son of David! Hosanna in the highest!
- * Mark 11:9-Hosanna! V.10 Hosanna in the highest!
- * John 12:13-They took palm branches and went out to meet him, shouting, Hosanna!
- *The waving of the palm branches was the welcome for visitors or kings and even now is a common demonstration to welcome a king, conqueror or deliverer.

II. Blessed is the one who comes in the name of the LORD-Psalm 118:26

- * Mat 21:9-Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord!
- * Mark 11:9-Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord! V.10 Blessed is the coming kingdom of our father David!
- * Luke 19:38-Blessed is the king who comes in the name of the Lord! Peace in heaven and glory in the highest!
- * John 12:13-Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord! Blessed is the King of Israel!
- *The roads leading into Jerusalem carried along caravans of pilgrims giving thanks to the name of the LORD, chanting psalms of praise to God. They sang the Psalms of Ascent PS 122.1 and as they passed through the gate, they declared PS 122.2

Closing thoughts: The Hebrew of PS 118.26 says "Blessed is the king who comes," but the Master's disciples threw caution to the wind and declared: "Baruch HaMelech Haba! Blessed is the King who comes!"


