The POWER of the resurrection

Introduction: "What happened as a result of the Resurrection is unprecedented in human history. Power from the Spirit. Romans 8.11 & 1 Peter 3.18 *God has power over life and death.

II. The nature of Christ's crucified body.

It was physical. *He ate-Luke 24.41-43 & He could be touched John 20.27

It was a glorified body. 1 Cor 15.442-44 & Ph 3.21

*Jesus was not a ghost. He did not return as a spirit. His body was resurrected into the imperishable body that had been promised.

III. Resurrection power in us!


To live a new life! Romans 6.4-7
