Luke 24.13-35

I. Blurry vision

Trying to make sense of it all. V. 13-15 Not able to recognize Jesus. V. 15-16

• There are times that we can't see what God is doing.

II. Q&A

Jesus asks them what they are discussing as they walk. V. 17 Uncle Cleopas shares their confusion about what has happened. V. 18-24

• They heard the truth about Jesus being alive but couldn't bring themselves to believe it.

III. Slow on the uptake

Admonishment. V. 25-26

Contents of the discourse-TaNacK v. 25-27

T for Torah-Abraham and Isaac (the sacrifice of his son). Joseph (saved and forgave his brothers). The sacrificial system as a whole with all it's ceremonies and rites.

N is the prophets: Nevi'im- Zech 12.10, Amos 8.9, Isaiah 52.13-53.12 (written in 740 to 680 B.C.)

K is for writings: Ketuvim- Ps 16:7-11 & Ps 22.1-2, 6-8, 12-19.

• They were shown through the scriptures that the "Christ had to suffer these things and then enter His glory".

IV. Open eyes and burning hearts

Breaking of bread-Blessed are you, Lord our God, King of the universe, who brings forth bread from the earth. V. 30-31 When scriptures penetrate our hearts...v. 32

• When we have a desire to see God, He will make His presence known to us. Though these two disciples had spent time with the Master, they still struggled to understand the ways of God. We need to pray, study, and discuss scripture together to continue to grow closer to God.

Closing thoughts: Jesus gave his disciples the opportunity to extend the invitation to Him to stay. He does not force entry into our lives. Luke **24.28-29**
