and to revive the heart of the contrite.”*

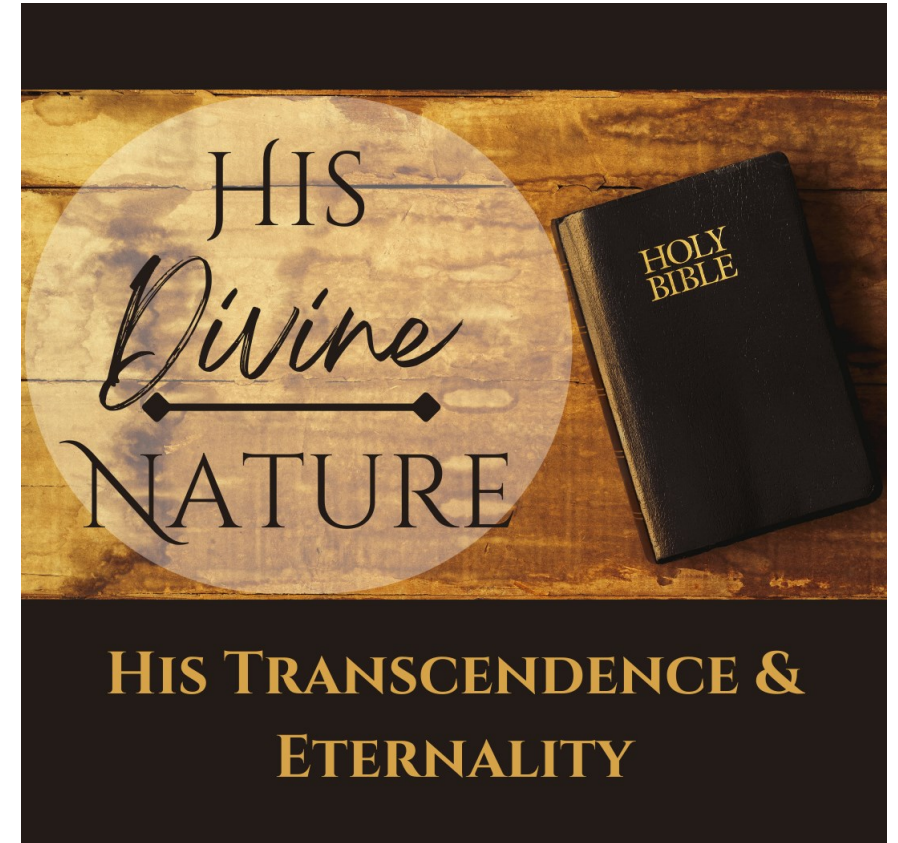
I. God is eternal
