


(prayed over by the elders) <u>Prayer Requests</u>



The World's Most Notable Event

Introduction:

Some of us stay at the cross, some of us wait at the tomb, Quickened and raised with Christ yet lingering still in the gloom. Some of us 'bide at the Passover feast with Pentecost all unknown, The triumphs of grace in the heavenly place that our Lord has made His own. If the Christ who died had stopped at the cross, His work had been incomplete. If the Christ who was buried had stayed in the tomb, He had only known defeat, But the way of the cross never stops at the cross and the way of the tomb leads on to victorious grace in the heavenly place where the risen Lord has gone.

Matthew 28:1-10

I. The notable earthquake. V. 2-6

- A supernatural event.
- A supernatural revelation. (Christ was not in the grave!) * Have you had your life shaken up?
- II. The notable message. V. 5-7
- Delivered by an angel.
- To be shared by all believers.
- * Have you recognized that He has risen from the grave?

III. The notable appearance. V. 9-10

- The resurrected Lord!
- The revelation calls for devotion.
- * Have you committed your life to Jesus?

Closing thoughts:

- What the women found.
 - ◇ "He is not here; for He is risen, as He said. Come, see the place where the Lord lay" (Mt. 28:6 NKJV).
- What you *can* do through Christ.
 - "God's power is very great for us who believe. That power is the same as the great strength God used to raise Christ from the dead" (Eph. 1:19-20 NCV).
 - "I can do all things through Christ, because he gives me the strength" (Phil. 4:13 NCV).

Make this prayer a part of your Easter celebration.


