Introduction: Jesus says 3 things to the invalid at the pool of Bethesda. Today we will look at each one to see how they apply to our own lives.

I. Do you want to get well?

- A. I have no one to help me.
- B. Someone else goes down ahead of me.
- *Do you ever "settle" for the situation you find yourself in? Or blame others for your problems?

II. Get Up! Pick up your mat and walk.

- A. At once he was healed
- B. He picked up his mat and walked. He believed and walked out his belief.
- *Do you believe? Are you willing to "pick up your mat and walk"?

III. See, you are well again. Stop sinning or something worse may happen to you.

- A. Did he do something in his past that caused him to be disabled?
- B. Why did Jesus warn him to stop sinning?

Conclusion- There are worse things than not getting healed of sickness and disease. Perhaps Jesus was talking about forgiveness?
