II. Introspectively study the Word. V. 22-25


Apply the Word to your life. V.22 Don't forget what you learned. V. 23-24 Receive the blessing of transformation. V. 25

Conclusion- A danger in reading God's Word is to think about how it applies to others instead of ourselves. We can also read it as simply stories that other people lived but not as God's living Word meant to transform us. James challenges us to see ourselves as we study and then be changed.
