Spiritual adultery. V. 4-5


Submit to God. V. 7 (surrender)

Conclusion- God wants to change us from the inside out. This is sanctification. "This Christ provides for. The first thing to do is to surrender yourself to be crucified with Jesus Christ. Sanctification is not improving your habits by culture, nor is it cleansing your heart; but it is handing the natural life over to death as a useless thing, so bad that you can never make it good, and getting instead something entirely new through union with Jesus Christ. Sanctification is receiving Him to dwell within you, to work through you, to be your substitute, and to give you His Holy Spirit instead of your old heart." A. B. Simpson
