Hagar, From Humble Beginnings

Gen 16 & 21:9-17

Introduction: Hagar was an Egyptian who was given to Abraham and Sarah as a servant. Sarah gave her to Abraham as his wife so that she could have a child for her. She eventually became the mother of the Arabs (through Ishmael).

I. Hagar's marriage. 16:1-6

Hagar was given by Sarai to Abram, they slept together, and Abram became pregnant. V.2-4

Hagar despised her mistress. V. 4-5

Abram reaffirms that Hagar is still a servant to Sarai. V. 6

Hagar started to feel that she was now the #1 wife and had sup-
planted Sarai, Abram told her otherwise.

II. Hagar's divine appointment. 16:7-16

The angel of the Lord confirms Hagar's place in the family. V. 7-
9

The promise of God. V.10

Ishmael- "God Hears" v. 11-12

Hagar names God- "You are the God who sees me. Beer Lahai
Roi-well of the Living God who sees me.

God doesn't take Hagar out of her circumstances, but He does
meet with her and make her a promise.

III. Hagar's divine appointment (part two). 21:8-17

Ishmaels mocking attitude leads to expulsion. V. 8-14

Promises reestablished. V. 12-13

God intervenes. V. 17-21

God speaks to Hagar a 2nd time and lets her know that their
cries have been heard and that God is going to keep His
promise.

***Lessons from her life: Sometimes it appears that God has for-
gotten us or the promises He has made us. This is never true.
He is still the God who hears and the God who sees you.***
